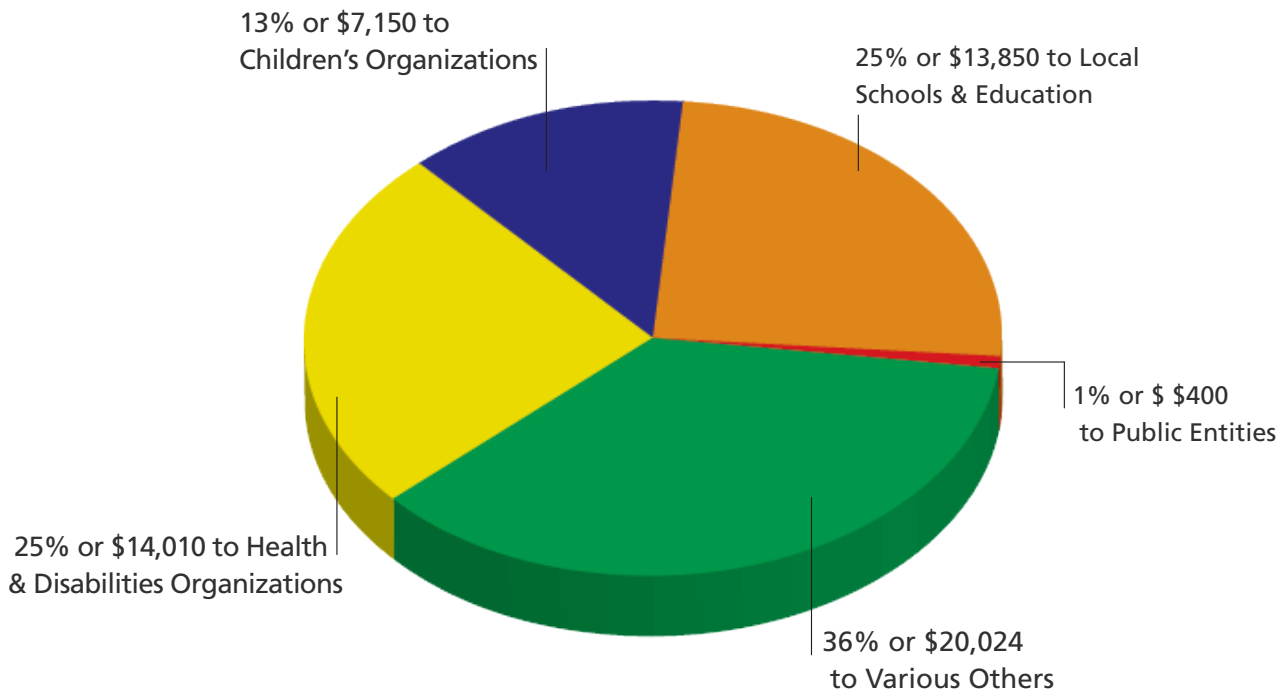


Adelanto ICE Processing Center Donates \$25K in Scholarships for Graduating Seniors

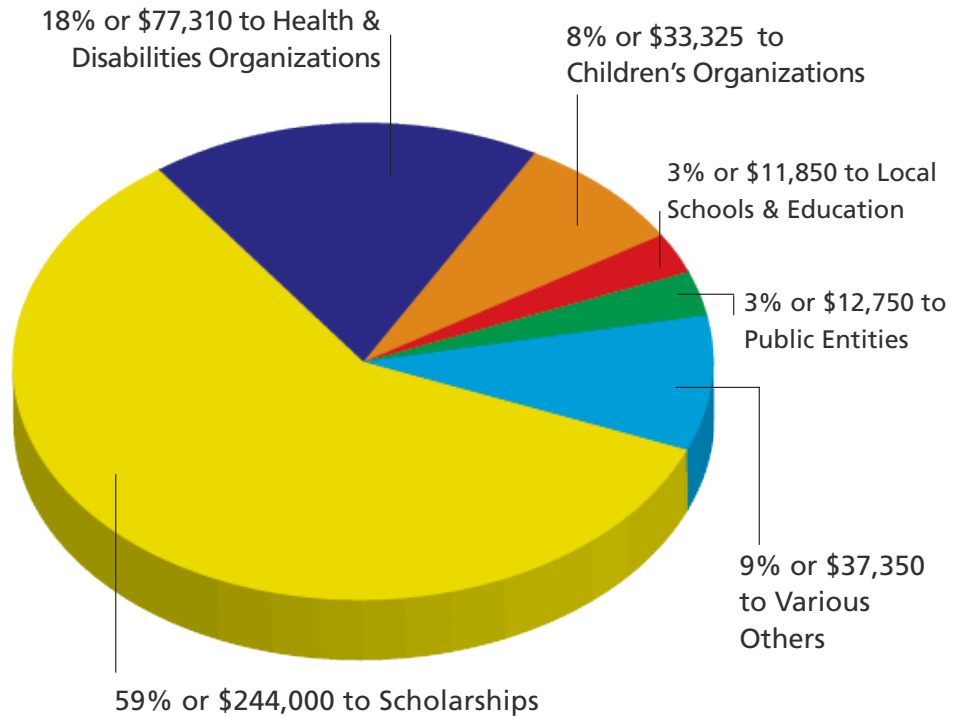

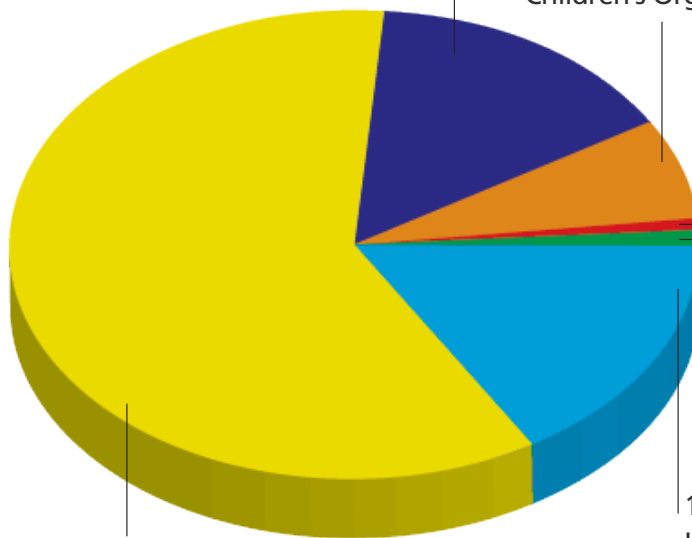

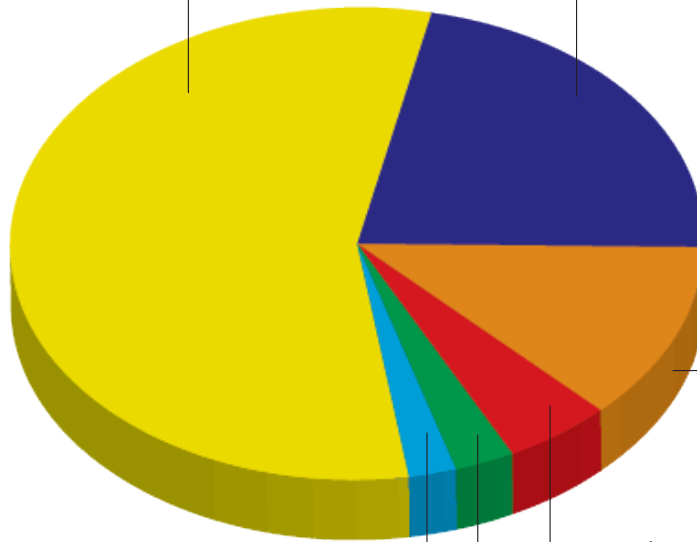
