across the nation received GEO Foundation Scholarships.


The GEO Foundation donated to the American Cancer Society in **8** different Facilities in **6** different states.


Eastern Region GEO Group Foundation Donations


Central Region GEO Group Foundation Donations


Western Region GEO Group Foundation Donations
