# The GEO Group Foundation 2016 YEAR IN REVIEW

In 2016, The GEO Foundation made approximately

#### **\$1.9 Million**

in charitable donations both at the Corporate and Facility level.

More than 100 local schools received GEO Foundation donations.






#### LaSalle Awards Student Scholarships


#### Central Region's Charity Golf Tournament






# Central Region GEO Group Foundation Donations

# Total: \$373,640






## Western Region GEO Group Foundation Donations
