



#### GEO Continuum of Care Alumni Give Back to the Community for the Holidays

During the holidays, South Bay Correctional and Rehabilitation Facility Alumni and President of Dignity Speaks, Inc., Elmo Golden recently partnered with The Life Center, GEO Continuum of Care Leadership, and local alumni to feed over 150 families in West Palm Beach. The Life Center is a faith-based organization in West Palm Beach dedicated to enhancing the holistic development of individuals, families, and communities.

#### **Supporting our Community**

The Guadalupe County Correctional Facility (GCCF) loves supporting our community. Santa Rosa is a small, remote town located in the third poorest county in New Mexico. The town is over 100 miles away from any large city. We may be small and have limited resources, but we are rich in heart and community. Santa Rosa loves its youth and so does GCCF. This year, we were able to give \$6,000 in scholarships to high school seniors and \$5,000 to students involved in agricultural programs such as FFA and 4-H.

## **GEO Conducts Annual Toy Drive for Boys Town**

Every year, The GEO Group engages with Boys Town of South Florida to coordinate an annual toy drive. Boys Town of South Florida provides an array of life-changing youth care and health care services that meet each child and family exactly where they are, so they get the right kind of care, at the right time, in the right way. In December 2020, Daniela Mesquita, Development Director for Boys Town, informed GEO that due to the pandemic, the organization had originally planned to only give children gift cards for Christmas.


## HTCF Donates to Local High School Scholarship Fund


# Eastern Region GEO Foundation Donations

# Central Region GEO Foundation Donations




