2025 PREA Annual Report

INTRODUCTION

In 2025, The GEO Group, Inc. received a total of 414 allegations of sexual abuse and harassment involving detainees, residents, and inmates. The report includes data from 58 secure and non-secure residential facilities and provides information regarding the types and outcomes of these allegations, as well as the measures taken to prevent and respond to incidents of sexual misconduct.

REPORTING PERIOD

As required by the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA), Pub. L. No. 108-79 (2003), The GEO Group, Inc. (GEO) has collected and reviewed data on allegations reported from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025. GEO produced this report in compliance with 28 C.F.R. § 115.87-89. This data was collected through the review of the following information:

- Information entered by PREA compliance managers in GEO's PREA database; and,
- Reports/investigations from GEO's Office of Professional Responsibility (OPR).

In 2025, there were a total of 414 allegations that met the definitions of sexual abuse or harassment. This report reflects the status of 2025 allegations as of June 1, 2026. As of June 1, 2026, 52 of 414 investigations remained on-going from the calendar year 2025. Of the 52 on-going investigations, 52 are being conducted by outside law enforcement agencies.

POLICY SUMMARY²

GEO mandates zero tolerance towards all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment in all its facilities. It is GEO's policy that sexual conduct between employees, volunteers, or contractors and inmates/detainees/residents, regardless of consensual status, is prohibited and subject to administrative, criminal, and disciplinary sanctions. Personal identifiers were omitted from this report to ensure the safety and security of staff and individuals housed in our facilities.

GEO FACILITIES COVERED THIS REPORT (58 FACILITIES)

This report contains PREA data collected from all GEO Facilities covered by DOJ PREA Standards. It does not contain PREA data collected from GEO facilities housing Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) detainees, as these facilities fall under the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) SAAPI Standards and data from these facilities will be reported as required by DHS. This report includes a comparison of 2024 and 2025 data as required by PREA Standard § 115.88 - Data review for corrective action.

The following 58 facilities are covered in this report:

- 25 U.S. Secure Services facilities
- 33 Residential Reentry Centers

GENERAL DEFINITIONS⁴

- **Contractor:** a person who provides services on a recurring basis pursuant to a contractual agreement with the agency.
- **Detainee:** any person detained in a lockup, regardless of adjudication status.
- **Employee:** a person who works directly for the agency or facility.
- **Inmate:** any person incarcerated or detained in a prison or jail.
- **On-going (OG):** investigation has not been completed.
- **Resident:** any person confined or detained in a juvenile facility or in a community confinement facility.
- **Staff:** employees.⁵
- **Substantiated (SUB):** an allegation that was investigated and determined to have occurred.
- **Unfounded (UF):** an allegation that was investigated and determined not to have occurred.
- **Unsubstantiated (UNSUB):** an allegation that was investigated and the investigation produced insufficient evidence to make a final determination as to whether or not the event occurred.
- **Volunteer:** an individual who donates time and effort on a recurring basis to enhance the activities and programs of the agency.

DEFINITIONS RELATED TO SEXUAL ABUSE & HARASSMENT⁶

• Sexual Abuse

- (1) Sexual abuse of an inmate, detainee, or resident by another inmate, detainee, or resident; and
- (2) Sexual abuse of an inmate, detainee, or resident by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer.

Sexual abuse of an inmate, detainee, or resident by another inmate, detainee, or resident includes any of the following acts, if the victim does not consent, is coerced into such act by overt or implied threats of violence, or is unable to consent or refuse:

- (1) Contact between the penis and the vulva or the penis and the anus, including penetration, however slight;
- (2) Contact between the mouth and the penis, vulva, or anus;
- (3) Penetration of the anal or genital opening of another person, however slight, by a hand, finger, object, or other instrument; and
- (4) Any other intentional touching, either directly or through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or the buttocks of another person, excluding contact incidental to a physical altercation.

Sexual abuse of an inmate, detainee, or resident by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer includes any of the following acts, with or without consent of the inmate, detainee, or resident:

- (1) Contact between the penis and the vulva or the penis and the anus, including penetration, however slight;
- (2) Contact between the mouth and the penis, vulva, or anus;
- (3) Contact between the mouth and any body part where the staff member, contractor, or volunteer has the intent to abuse, arouse, or gratify sexual desire;
- (4) Penetration of the anal or genital opening, however slight, by a hand, finger, object, or other instrument, that is unrelated to official duties or where the staff member, contractor, or volunteer has the intent to abuse, arouse, or gratify sexual desire;
- (5) Any other intentional contact, either directly or through the clothing, of or with the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or the buttocks, that is unrelated to official duties or where the staff member, contractor, or volunteer has the intent to abuse, arouse, or gratify sexual desire;
- (6) Any attempt, threat, or request by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer to engage in the activities described in paragraphs (1)-(5) of this section;
- (7) Any display by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer of his or her uncovered genitalia, buttocks, or breast in the presence of an inmate, detainee, or resident, and
- (8) Voyeurism by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer.

Voyeurism by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer means an invasion of privacy of an inmate, detainee, or resident by staff for reasons unrelated to official duties, such as peering at an inmate who is using a toilet in his or her cell to perform bodily functions; requiring an inmate to expose his or her buttocks, genitals, or breasts; or taking images of all or part of an inmate's naked body or of an inmate performing bodily functions.

- **Sexual Harassment**

- (1) Repeated and unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or verbal comments, gestures, or actions of a derogatory or offensive sexual nature by one inmate, detainee, or resident directed toward another; and
- (2) Repeated verbal comments or gestures of a sexual nature to an inmate, detainee, or resident by a staff member, contractor, or volunteer, including demeaning references to gender, sexually suggestive or derogatory comments about body or clothing, or obscene language or gestures.

INCIDENT TYPE ACRONYMS

The following acronyms are used by GEO to track reported allegations of sexual abuse and harassment:

- **IISA** – Inmate-on-Inmate or Detainee-on-Detainee Sexual Abuse
- **IISH** – Inmate-on-Inmate or Detainee-on-Detainee Sexual Harassment
- **SISA** – Staff-on-Inmate or Staff-on-Detainee Sexual Abuse
- **SISH** – Staff-on-Inmate or Staff-on-Detainee Sexual Harassment

EVIDENTIARY STANDARD

The agency shall impose no standard higher than a preponderance of the evidence in determining whether allegations of sexual abuse or sexual harassment are substantiated.⁷

In 2025, there were 414 allegations in the four incident types listed above.⁸ Every allegation was referred for investigation and a total of 36 allegations, 17 sexual abuse and 19 sexual harassment, were substantiated. All cases involving staff were received, assessed, and processed by GEO's Office of Professional Responsibility. When criminal activity was suspected, GEO referred the allegations of sexual abuse or sexual harassment to an agency with the legal authority to conduct criminal investigations.⁹

- GEO received 414 allegations in 2025, a decrease from 489 in 2024. This is a decrease of 75 allegations.
- U.S. Secure Services received 334 allegations in 2025, a decrease from 412 in 2024. This is a decrease of 78 allegations.
- Reentry Services received 80 allegations in 2025, an increase from 77 in 2024. This is an increase of 3 allegations.

⁸ Over the past three years, GEO has experienced an overall fluctuation in PREA allegations, with an increase in 2024 followed by a decline in 2025. In 2023, there were total of 453 allegations reported, which rose by approximately 8% to 489 allegations in 2024. Most recently, in 2025, there was a 16% decrease in allegations from 2024, totaling 413 allegations. All allegations with suspected criminal activity are referred to an agency with the legal authority to conduct criminal investigations.

- There were 36 substantiated allegations GEO-wide in 2025, a decrease from 59 in 2024. This is a decrease of 22 substantiated allegations.
- There were 24 substantiated allegations for U.S. Secure Services in 2025, a decrease from 44 in 2024. This is a decrease of 20 substantiated allegations.
- There were 12 substantiated allegations for Reentry Services in 2025, a decrease from 15 in 2024. This is a decrease of 3 substantiated allegations.

- There were 174 IISA allegations reported to GEO in 2025, a decrease from 242 in 2024. This is a decrease of 68 IISA allegations.
- There were 160 IISA allegations reported to U.S. Secure Services in 2025, a decrease from 213 in 2024. This is a decrease of 53 IISA allegations.
- There were 14 IISA allegations reported to Reentry Services in 2025, a decrease from 29 in 2024. This is a decrease of 15 IISA allegations.

- There were 125 IISH allegations reported to GEO in 2025, an increase from 87 in 2024. This is an increase of 38 IISH allegations.

- There were 103 IISH allegations reported to U.S. Secure Services in 2025, an increase from 80 in 2024. This is an increase of 23 IISH allegations.
- There were 22 IISH allegations reported to Reentry Services in 2025, an increase from 7 in 2024. This is an increase of 15 IISH allegations.

- There were 81 SISA allegations reported to GEO in 2025, a decrease from 97 in 2024. This is a decrease of 16 SISA allegations.
- There were 51 SISA allegations reported to U.S. Secure Services in 2025, a decrease from 70 in 2024. This is a decrease of 19 SISA allegations.
- There were 30 SISA allegations reported to Reentry Services in 2025, an increase from 27 in 2024. This is an increase of 3 SISA allegations.

- There were 34 SISH allegations reported to GEO in 2025, a decrease from 63 in 2024. This is a decrease of 29 SISH allegations.
- There were 20 SISH allegations reported to U.S. Secure Services in 2025, a decrease from 49 in 2024. This is a decrease of 29 SISH allegations.
- There were 14 SISH allegations reported to Reentry Services in 2025, no change from 14 in 2024.

2025 PROGRAM ENHANCEMENTS

Actions in 2025:

In 2025, GEO implemented the following actions to enhance the prevention and detection of any incidents and to enhance responses to allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment:

- **Corporate Contract Compliance Department Enhancements**
 - Monthly PREA training sessions continued to be delivered by subject matter experts to PREA compliance managers, specialized investigators, and compliance staff. Each session addressed targeted PREA-related topics, with an increased emphasis on emerging trends, audit findings, and operational challenges. These sessions supported ongoing professional development, strengthened subject matter expertise, and reinforced best practices to ensure consistent, high-quality compliance and service delivery across all facilities.

- Attended the National PREA Coordinator's Conference in Madison, WI, gaining valuable insights and best practices to strengthen institutional compliance and enhance sexual safety practices.
- Participated in quarterly National PREA Coordinators Working Group meetings, promoting collaboration and knowledge sharing with professionals nationwide to support continuous improvement and alignment with national standards.
- Promoted Sexual Assault Awareness Month across all facilities through coordinated awareness activities and educational materials, fostering a culture of prevention, support, and zero tolerance for sexual abuse.
- Conducted a comprehensive review of PREA policies to ensure alignment with federal standards and evolving best practices, reinforcing organizational compliance and consistency across facilities.

- **Training and education of employees, contractors and volunteers**

- Employees, contractors, and volunteers received annual PREA in-service training as required by GEO policies in 2025.
- Thirty-four employees from U.S. Secure Services and Residential Reentry Centers received PREA Specialized Investigator's Training in 2025.
- Approximately 80 U.S. Secure Services and Residential Reentry Center staff attended and received standard-specific PREA training monthly. These sessions drove increased consistency in PREA application, strengthened staff decision-making, and contributed to improved audit readiness and reduced compliance deficiencies.

- **Assessment of Physical Plant Issues at Facilities**

- • Annual PREA Facility Assessments were conducted in all GEO U.S. Secure Services and Residential Reentry Centers to identify areas needing improvement to enhance the company's ability to protect individuals from sexual abuse and sexual harassment. All recommendations for enhancements were submitted and reviewed by the corporate PREA coordinator and appropriate divisional authority. Examples of enhancements include:
 - Three facilities initiated the process of upgrading their video surveillance systems.
 - Six facilities added additional cameras to enhance monitoring and eliminate blind spots.
 - One facility increased the frequency of security rounds, resulting in greater staff visibility and more consistent monitoring of residents.
 - Three facilities added new mirrors in strategic locations, resulting in improved visibility, reduced blind spots, and enhanced staff supervision.
 - To improve accessibility and ensure understanding across diverse populations, the comprehensive education manual was translated into 8 new languages.
 - One facility Installed a T.V in a high traffic area with the PREA resident education video playing on a continuous loop to help increase resident awareness.
 - One facility conducted refresher training on PREA standards and first responder duties periodically, including integration into shift briefings and department head meetings.
